

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PEDESTAL LAVATORIES



Thank you for selecting the Crane Plumbing pedestal lavatory. To insure this product is installed properly, please read these instructions carefully before you begin. This high quality, vitreous china fixture is meant to provide many years of service, but can be damaged by improper handling and/or installation. Be sure your installation conforms to local codes.

PRE INSTALLATION

Unpack the lavatory and pedestal. Take a moment to check the fixtures to make sure there is no damage. Verify that you have all the necessary tools, fittings, and connection hardware to complete the installation.

INSTALLATION

- 1 Provide suitable structural support behind the finished wall for the hanger lag screws.

The wall, or whatever material the screws are attached to, must be of sufficient strength to fully support the lavatory.

It may be necessary to install a 2 x 6 board behind the finished wall. Position the board between two studs, and above the floor so the mounting screws will be installed at the centerline of the 2 x 6. (See Figure 1).



- 2 Set the lavatory on the pedestal base and position it against the wall in its final installed location.

Use a level to assure that the lavatory top is level front to back and side to side. Verify that there is proper clearance and fit for the supply fittings, waste outlet, drain pop up, etc. (See Figure 2).



- 3 Reach up under the back of the lavatory and position the hanger so that it is making proper contact with the wall and the angled surface that is molded into the underside of the lavatory. The hanger should also be centered in relation to the centerline of the lavatory and the pedestal. Mark the location of the hanger on the wall.

- 4 Remove the lavatory and pedestal. Position the hanger, aligned with the marked location on the wall, and securely fasten it to the wall. A minimum of four 8 x 1-1/2" wood or lag screws should be used to attach the hanger to the wall. (See Figure 3)



5 Assemble the faucet(s) and pop up to the lavatory. (See Figure 4)

6 Hang the lavatory on the wall hanger. Position the pedestal under the lavatory - lift the front of the lavatory as necessary to place the pedestal the proper position. (See Figure 5)

7 Connect and tighten the water supply fittings, waste piping, and pop up. (See Figure 6)

Install the hold down clips or screws to secure the lavatory top to the wall. (not applicable to all lavatory models).

8 Install an 8 x 1" wood or lag screw in the bottom of the pedestal to secure it to the floor (Figure 7) and prevent lateral movement. (Not applicable to all models).

Do Not overtighten the screws as this can crack the china.

This fixture is virtually maintenance free. Clean it with any non-abrasive household cleaner and a soft cloth. Avoid striking it with metal objects, as they tend to mar the surface. These marks, or heavy soil, can be removed with a soft cleaner meant for glazed surfaces.






